

# Be it Remembered That the

Edrus Lloyd.

Thirteenth day of September in the year of our said Lord one thousand six hundred Seventy and nyne Edward Lloyd of Bath in the parish of Dorstowen in the County of Gloucester Esquire being sick in body - (with his dwelling house in Bath aforesaid) But of good and perfect understanding memory and speech (Trusting be to Almighty God) - Did make and ordaine his last will and Testament in manner and forme following First and above all things he did Comend his soule into the mercifull hand of Almighty God his Creator Redeemer and Sanctifier And his body to be buried in Christian burall as then he did give and bequath the sume of ffifty pounde of Lawfull English money for a Stole to the poore of the said parish of Dorstowen for ever The use or interest thereof to be debided betwixne the poore of the said parish on Good Fryday yearly for ever according to the direction of the said Minister Churchwardens and others of the said parish of the oldest freeholders of the said parish yf then he did give devise and bequath unto Edward Lloyd his Nephew one Myssage or Tenement lying in Sandycroft in the County of Carmarthen with the devise of what his wife he satisfying - unto such person or persons the sume of ffive hundred pounde of Lawfull English money as the said Edward Lloyd his said wife should appoint by her last will and Testament in writing or otherwise yf then he did give devise and bequath unto Henry Lloyd sonne of his Brother John Lloyd one Tenement of Land of about Seven pounde per Annum after the decease of Elizabeth Lloyd his sister in the said Elizabeth to enjoy the same quietly during her life which said Tenement at that lying and being in the said County of Carmarthen yf then he did give and bequath unto Anne Lloyd his deare wife towards payeing the said Legacies his Debts and Expenses and proving his will and towards his estate of Lawfull English money and goods Chattells Lutes Jewels and stuffe Bills Bonds and debts what soever And lastly he did make and ordaine his said deare wife Anne Lloyd to be his sole Executrix of his said last will And he did give the persons subscribed to take notice hereof and in pursuance hereof to use the words to that effect. *Witness* to this will Charles Lloyd Clerk. *Witness* to this will. *Witness* to this will.
