In the name of God Amen

Twenty day of May in the an[n]y twentith yea[r] of the reign of our subuaigne
Lord Charles the first in our thousand six hundred forty and first of William
the first of the parish of Dorseton in the County and Dioc[ese] of Exeter do give and bequeath
with me bodie out of goods and chattels and money, frankes and tenures, to be giuen to
Almighty God to make any and euery thinge my last will and Testament in manner
and forme following. First I desire and bequeath my soule into the hands of
God and of Christ Jesus my only Saviour and Redeemer by whose death I hope for
inheritance of eternal life and my body to be buried in decent buriall in the church church
of Dorseton at the discretion of my friends whom I do give and bequeath one shilling
towards the repairation of the same church, aforsayd of the said give and bequeath
ten shillings to be paid of the parish of Dorseton to be equally diuided betwix
them by Mr William Clarke and Mr John W. Lady with me and Marthe after my
decease the said give and bequeath ten shillings to the poor of the parish of
Dorseton to be equally diuided betwix them by Mr David Clarke and William
the first in one month next after my decease the said give and bequeath
the summe of forty two pounds of lawfull money of England in the hands of
George Thomas at the parish of Buddwardine in the County of
Exeter to be paid unto my daughter for paym[ent] and seruants of the said
George Thomas and the interest thereof of the said George Thomas at the parish
of Buddwardine the said lands in Buddwardine aforsayd as by
one paym[ent] of the said mortgage made betwix the said George
and Sibell his wife on the one parte and me the said William the first
on the other parte may plainly app[ea]re whiche deed of Mortgage the said
lands and money and all my estate right by the said interest thereof I give
grante devise and bequeath to the said George and my daughter to haue and to
hold to the said George and lands unto the said George and her heires for ever
to the said and only to the said and to his heires of the said George and
of her heires according to the said parts before and then meaning of the said deed
of the said give and bequeath unto Elizabeth my wife the summe of six pounds
and

and eight things in the hands of the said Thomas at Northward being the
interest of the said four hundred pounds for the year last past before the date hereof
And I do assign and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth my wife the full and
wholly interest of the said four hundred pounds unto the said Elizabeth my daughter shall
accompany the age of sixteen years or if the said Elizabeth shall remain
and remain in the said widowhood of the said Thomas and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth
my wife the sum of five and twenty pounds of lawful English money with
the interest of the said four hundred pounds in Mortgage upon the lands of the said Thomas
of the County of Northampton and for default of payment of
the said five and twenty pounds according to the day and by the said Thomas
a party of the said mortgage had and made between the said Thomas
Hill and Jane his wife on the one part and me the said William Hill on
the other part I do give and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth my wife all
my estate right title and interest of lands in all the said lands of the said Thomas
in the said County of Northampton according to the several parts
and true meaning of the said mortgage to have and to hold all the said lands with the
rights and appurtenances thereto in the said mortgage unto the said Elizabeth
my wife and her heirs forever to the said Elizabeth my wife and the said Elizabeth

my wife the sum of five and twenty pounds with the interest thereof due to
me by special licence from Thomas J. Demond of the parish of St. Andrew's fourpence
and sixpence the said Elizabeth and my will is that the said twenty five
pounds shall remain and be retained to my son James at her decease if he shall
live so long as he doth give and bequeath unto my said son James the sum of
fifteen pounds of lawful money with the interest being in Mortgage upon the
lands of David Charles of the parish of Northampton in the County of Northampton
and for default of payment of the said fifteen pounds unto the said James according
to a party of the said mortgage had and made between the said David
Charles and me the said Thomas and bequeath unto my estate right title and interest
of and in the said lands unto the said James my son and his heirs forever according to
the said mortgage and the meaning of the said mortgage of the said David Charles
and bequeath unto the said James my son the sum of five pounds and four shillings
of lawful English money due to me by special licence from John J. Demond of the parish
of St. Michael's in the County of Northampton and for default of payment of the said
five pounds unto the said James my son and his heirs forever to the said James
and bequeath four shillings to the said David Charles towards a certain debt of my
decease and my will is that the said Elizabeth my wife shall pay and discharge all my
debts whatsoever and finally I do nominate ordain and appoint my wife
Elizabeth my wife sole executrix of my last will and testament to perform
the same subscribed being present at the sealing publishing and reading hereof
W. B. Seal and witnessed in the presence of the said James Hill William
